PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE IN AIRLIE GARDENS OUTSIDE HOLLAND PARK SCHOOL AT SCHOOL DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP TIMES

*Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. *) Traffic Order 2026*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to provide a pedestrian and cycle zone in **Airlie Gardens**, in the whole length that is public highway, between 8.00 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. and between 3.00 p.m. and 3.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

[Note: (1) Foot scooters, e-scooters, emergency vehicles, Dial-a-ride buses, and minibuses serving the school will be exempt from the closures. Residents and traders who live or work in the section of road referred to above will be able to register for an exemption. (2) The pedestrian and cycle zone will operate at the times stated above, although in practice it is anticipated that it will only operate during these hours in school term-time, when physical barriers are installed on street].

3. Anyone who wishes to support or object to these proposals or make any other representations in respect of them, should send a statement in writing to that effect, and in the case of an objection, stating the grounds thereof by email to: trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk or by post to Traffic Orders, Transportation and Highways, Kensington Town Hall, Hornton Street, London W8 7NX quoting reference "School Streets – Airlie Gardens" by **1st July 2026**.
