## PROVISION OF A ROUTE FOR PEDESTRIANS AND PEDAL CYCLES ONLY, A PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE AND REMOVAL OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM IN PART OF BASIL STREET AND PROVISION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM SYTEM AND ASSOCIATED 'NO ENTRY' IN PART OF PAVILION ROAD

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. \*) Traffic Order 2023

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to:
  - (a) provide a route for the use of pedestrians and pedal cycles only in Basil Street, between the western kerb-line of Sloane Street and 14 metres south-west of that kerb-line, prohibiting all motor vehicles from entering that length;
  - (b) provide a pedestrian and cycle zone in Basil Street, between Pavilion Road and 14 metres southwest of the western kerb-line of Sloane Street (vehicles would be permitted to enter the pedestrian and cycle zone to access properties);
  - (c) remove the north-eastbound one-way system in Basil Street, between Pavilion Road and Sloane Street; and
  - (d) provide a southbound one-way system in Pavilion Road, between Basil Street and Hans Crescent (reversing the existing one-way system in this length), along with the associated prohibition of entry against the flow of traffic at the southern end of that length.

[Note: some of the above changes are introducing permanent restrictions that have already been introduced on-street via a temporary Traffic Order]
