Beauchamp Place Streetscape Improvements:

Consultation results

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Introduction

The consultation focused on draft proposals to improve Beauchamp Place, Knightsbridge, for residents, businesses, and visitors.

The proposals include widening the pavements, improving the street surface, introducing traffic calming measures and planting new trees. They have been developed by a stakeholder group made up of local businesses and residents.

The consultation opened on 12/02/2024 and closed after six weeks on 24/03/2024.

It was promoted in person through door knocking and online (via email and newsletters). Consultees could respond by filling in the online form or contacting the project team.

We received 81 responses to the questionnaire.

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Key findings

Respondents' connection to Beauchamp Place:

- 62% (50 responses) from residents, 28 local and 22 in another part of K&C or further afield
- 28% (23 responses) from people who run a business or work in the borough, 17 respondents locally and the rest in another part of K&C
- 10% (8 responses) from visitors

Extent of support or opposition:

- 60% (49 responses) support or strongly support proposals
 - o Residents: 66%
 - o Business: 57%
 - Visitors: 3 (38%)
- 36% (29 responses) oppose or strongly oppose proposals
 - Residents: 34%
 - o Business: 35%
 - Visitors: 4 (50%)
- 4% (3 responses) neither support nor oppose proposals

Key reasons for supporting proposals:

- ✓ More attractive streetscape
- ✓ More opportunity for al-fresco dining
- ✓ Better pavements and accessibility
- ✓ Greening

Key reasons for opposing proposals:

- Impact on traffic and parking on neighbouring streets such as Ovington Square
- Traffic in the area is already under pressure because of works on Sloane Street
- Fear of al-fresco dining taking up pedestrian space

Who responded to the survey:

- Age: 47% (38 responses) over 55s, 31% (25 responses) 35-54, 5% (4 responses) under 35s
- Ethnicity: 68% (54 responses) any White background, 18% (14 responses) preferred not to state or have not answered, 9% (7 responses) any Asian or mixed Asian background, 2 any Black background, 2 any Arab background


Questionnaire

1: What is your connection to Beauchamp Place?

There were 81 responses to this part of the question.

Key takeaways:

- 62% (50 responses) from residents, 28 living locally and 22 living in another part of Kensington and Chelsea or further afield
- 28% (23 responses) from people who run a business or work in the borough, 17 respondents locally and the rest in another part of Kensington and Chelsea
- 10% (8 responses) from visitors



2: To what extent do you support or oppose the proposals for Beauchamp Place as shown in the drawings?

There were 81 responses to this part of the question.

Key takeaways:

- 60% (49 responses) support or strongly support proposals
 - o Residents: 66%
 - o Business: 57%
 - Visitors: 3 (38%)
- 4% (3 responses) neither support nor oppose proposals
- 36% (29 responses) oppose or strongly oppose proposals
 - Residents: 34%
 - Business: 35%
 - Visitors: 4 (50%)



3: Please share any comments or suggestions you may have about the

proposals.

There were 56 responses to this part of the question.

Key takeaways:

 Most comments supporting and strongly supporting the proposals are looking forward to the more attractive streetscape, more opportunity for al-fresco dining, better pavements and accessibility, and greening. They ask that loading bays are retained, and taxis have kerbside access for pick-up and drop off. Also better traffic management / parking enforcement.

- Most comments opposing and strongly opposing the proposals raise the impact on traffic and parking on neighbouring streets, particularly Ovington Square. Some say that traffic in the area is already under pressure because of the ongoing works on Sloane Street. Respondents suggest that any changes should retain the current road width and traffic flow. They also fear further conflicts between additional al-fresco dining taking up pedestrian space.
- To address concerns, respondents suggest clarifying the impact on traffic and parking on neighbouring streets, the scope of interventions regarding road width and future improved traffic management.

There were 80 responses to this part of the question.



There were 78 responses to this part of the question.



Key takeaways (out of 79 responses inc. 2 not answered at first then ethnicity specified on "Other" text box):


- 68% (54 responses) from any White background
