OAKLEY STREET AND OLD CHURCH STREET - BUS AND COACH BAN

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. 7) Traffic Order 2023

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 19 December 2023 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit all buses (including coaches) from entering Oakley Street and Old Church Street (between the south-eastern kerb-line of King's Road and the north-western kerb-line of Chelsea Embankment), excluding any part of those roads that is a red route side road. An exemption will apply to vehicles following a diversion route.
- 3. Copies of the Order, which will come in to force on 27 December 2023 and of all other relevant documents may be obtained via email for inspection by contacting trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk and can be inspected at The Council Offices, The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea, 37 Pembroke Road, London, W8 6PW between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made.
- 4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
