The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. *) Traffic Order 2024

All vehicles other than pedal cycles would be banned from entering the paved area in that part of Draycott Avenue that extends westwards from the building line between No. 161 and Nos. 163 to 165 Draycott Avenue to its junction with Walton Street.
