ELYSTAN STREET - CLOSURE OF PART OF ELYSTAN STREET TO ALL MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT MOTORCYCLES

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. 14) Traffic Order 2021

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 7th October 2021 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to continue indefinitely the provisions of The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2021, that is, to prevent all motor vehicles, other than motorcycles, from entering the length of Elystan Street that lies between the south-eastern kerb-line of Whitehead's Grove and the north-western kerb-line of Elystan Place.
- 3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 14th October 2021 and of all other relevant documents can be obtained via email for inspection by contacting <u>trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk</u> quoting reference "Elystan St prescribed routes perm" and can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made at The Customer Service Centre, Kensington Town Hall, Hornton Street, London W8 7NX.
- 4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
