- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") on 12th May 2025 will make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

- (nnn) on the south-west side of **Wallingford Avenue**, outside the flank wall of No. 37 St Quintin Avenue, situated in Wallingford Avenue, for 10.5 metres (34ft); and to update certain Articles and Schedules in The Kensington and Chelsea (Charged-For Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2023 and The Kensington and Chelsea (Free Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2023 to accurately reflect the provisions as they currently operate; and
- (000) to modify the traffic order definitions of certain other parking places and waiting restrictions so they better reflect what is currently on the ground (there would be no change to the way these restrictions and parking places currently operate on-street).
- 3. - 4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
