**GILSTON ROAD – EXEMPTION FOR PEDAL CYCLES FROM EXISTING ONE-WAY SYSTEM**

**Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. \*) Traffic Order 2022**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to exempt pedal cycles from the existing north-westbound one-way system in Gilston Road, between Fulham Road and Priory Walk.
3. The above measures would improve accessibility for cyclists in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.
