HOGARTH ROAD TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES (NCIL EC4)

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") proposes, under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to construct the type of road humps knows as "sinusoidal road humps" at the following locations on Hogarth Road (measurements are given from the centre line of the road hump):
 - (i) 2 metres north of the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 Hogarth Road;
 - (ii) 3 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 20 and 22 Hogarth Road;
 - (iii) 2 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 44 and 46 Hogarth Road; and
 - (iv) 4 metres north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 58 and 60 Hogarth Road.

[Note: Each "sinusoidal road hump" would be an elevated section of carriageway with a round top, 75mm millimetres higher at its highest point than the surrounding carriageway, approximately 7 metres wide and approximately 3.7 metres in length].

- 2. The road humps are being introduced as part of a scheme intended to reduce traffic speeds on Hogarth Road.
