The Kensington and Chelsea (Off-Street Parking Place) (Holland Park Car Park)
(Amendment No. 1) Order 2021

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 18th March 2021 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be:
 - (a) to provide that charge for use of the Holland Park Car Park will not apply on Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday or a bank holiday. [Note: Currently the charges do not apply on Christmas Day only and these changes would bring the days on which charges do not apply in the Holland Park Car Park in line with on-street parking charge provisions in the Borough on bank holidays and other public holidays]; and
 - (b) to make certain clerical changes to The Kensington and Chelsea (Off-Street Parking Place) (Holland Park Car Park) Order 2012, to accommodate the charges for use of the Holland Park car park varying according to vehicle type and payment method. [Note: these proposals do not change any existing parking charges].
- 3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 25th March 2021, and of all other relevant documents can be obtained for inspection via email until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made by contacting trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk, quoting reference: Holland Park Car Park Parking Charges Vehicles or by phoning 020 7361 2094.
- 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
