## HOLLAND STREET – EXEMPTION FOR PEDAL CYCLES FROM ONE-WAY SYSTEM AND NO-ENTRY RESTRICTION

## Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. \*) Traffic Order 2022

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to exempt pedal cycles from the eastbound one-way system in Holland Street, between Campden Hill Road and Hornton Street. Pedal cycles would also be made exempt from the 'no entry' restriction in place in relation to that one-way system, at the junction of Holland Street and Hornton Street
- 3. The above measures would improve accessibility for cyclists in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.
