## REMOVAL OF PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE AND PROVISION OF ONE-WAY EXCEPT CYCLES IN PART OF KENSINGTON PARK ROAD

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. X) Traffic Order 2024

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to:
  - (a) remove the pedestrian and cycle zone in that part of Kensington Park Road that lies between Blenheim Crescent and Elgin Crescent; and
  - (b) provide a south-eastbound one-way system applying to all vehicles except pedal cycles in Kensington Park Road, between Blenheim Crescent and Elgin Crescent, with an accompanying 'compulsory right turn except cycles' from Kensington Park Mews into Kensington Park Road.
