**LANSDOWNE CRESCENT
ROAD CLOSURE APPLYING TO MOTOR VEHICLES**

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. 15) Traffic Order 2021

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 21st October 2021 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to continue indefinitely the provisions of The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. 11) Experimental Traffic Order 2020, that is, to prevent motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in the length of Lansdowne Crescent (arm adjacent to St. John's Church) that lies between the south-western kerb-line of Ladbroke Grove and a point 7.5 metres south-west of that kerb-line. [Note: access will be retained for emergency vehicles]
3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 28th October 2021 and of all other relevant documents can be obtained via email for inspection by contacting trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk quoting reference "Lansdowne Cres perm" and can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made at The Customer Service Centre, Kensington Town Hall, Hornton Street, London W8 7NX.
4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
