LOWNDES SQUARE - PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN INTO WILLIAM STREET

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2023

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 5th January 2023 made the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit all vehicles, except for pedal cycles and authorised vehicles, travelling eastwards in the northern west to east arm of Lowndes Square from turning left into William Street. For the purposes of the exemption to the banned left turn, authorised vehicles means those dropping off or picking up passengers or delivering or collecting goods at properties within William Street.
- 3. Copies of the Order, which will come in to force on 12th January 2023 and of all other relevant documents may be obtained via email for inspection by contacting trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk quoting reference: "William Street" and can be inspected at the Customer Service Centre, Kensington and Chelsea Town Hall, Hornton Street, London W8 7NX during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
- 4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
