The Kensington and Chelsea (Free Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 5) Order 2021 and The Kensington and Chelsea (Charged–For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2021.

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") on 19th August 2021 have made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders will be:-
 - (a) on the south-west side of Addison Avenue, to convert 2 metres (7ft) of single yellow line (Monday to Friday 8.30am to 6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am to 1.30pm) outside No. 57 Addison Avenue to residents' parking. This two metres will be redistributed between four echelon residents' parking bays outside No. 57 Addison Avenue to make them wider;
 - (b) on the north-west side of **Bonchurch Road**, to convert 6.6 metres (22ft) of residents' parking outside Nos. 30 and 32 Bonchurch Road, to personalised disabled bay No. 742;
 - (c) on the south-east side of Cambridge Gardens, to convert 10 metres (33ft) of residents' parking (hours of control Monday to Friday 8.30am-6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am-1.30pm) opposite No. 12 Cambridge Gardens to 10 metres (33ft) of residents parking (hours of control Monday to Thursday 8.30am-6.30pm) and two Pay-by-phone bays (hours of control Friday 8.30am-6.30pm and Sat 8.30am-1.30pm, maximum stay 10 hours);
 - (d) on the north-west side of **Cornwall Crescent**, to convert 3 metres (10ft) of single yellow line (hours of control Monday to Friday 8.30am-6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am-1.30pm) outside No. 2 Cornwall Crescent to double yellow lines. This area will accommodate an on-street cycle hangar unit.
 - (e) on the north-west side of the unnamed road parallel to Ann Lane between Milman's Street and Riley Street within Cremorne Estate, to convert two RBKC-Housing residents' permit (CME) bays (nos. 46 and 47) to RBKC-Housing visitor permit (VIS) bays;
 - (f) on the south-east side of the unnamed road parallel to Ann Lane between Milman's Street and Riley Street within **Cremorne Estate**, to convert four RBKC-Housing visitor permit (VIS) bays (nos. 38 to 41) into three (wider) RBKC-Housing visitor permit (VIS) bays;
 - (g) on the north-west side of **Elgin Crescent**, to convert 3 metres (10ft) of residents' parking outside No. 28 Elgin Crescent to double yellow lines. This area will accommodate a cycle hangar unit;
 - (h) on the north-west side of **Elgin Crescent**, to convert 3 metres (10ft) of residents' parking outside No. 36 Elgin Crescent to double yellow lines. This area will accommodate a cycle hangar unit;
 - (i) on the south side of Elkstone Road, to convert 5 metres of Pay-by-Phone visitor parking bay (hours of control Monday to Friday 8.30am to 6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am-1.30pm, maximum stay four hours) and 1.6 metres (5ft) of at any time waiting restrictions outside Nos. 1 to 31 Elkstone Road, to a Blue Badge Disabled Bay (hours of control Monday to Friday 8.30am-6.30pm. No max stay outside these times, maximum stay 4 hours);
 - (j) on the south-west side of **Freston Road**, to convert 15 metres (49ft) of single yellow line (Monday to Friday 8.30am-6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am to 1.30pm) opposite Nos. 86 to 90 Freston Road to residents' parking;
 - (k) on the south-east side of **Fulham Road**, to convert 10 metres (33ft) of 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions outside the Chelsea and Westminster Hospital, situated in Fulham Road, to a taxi rank to operate Monday to Sunday, at all times;
 - on the north-east side of Harcourt Terrace, to convert three Pay-by-phone visitor parking bays (hours of control Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours) outside the flank wall of No. 26 Tregunter Road, situated in Harcourt Terrace, to residents' parking;
 - (m) on the south side of Harrington Road, to convert 5 metres (16ft) of residents' parking and 1.6 metres (5ft) of 'at any time' waiting and loading restrictions outside No. 27 Harrington Road, to a Blue Badge disabled bay (Monday to Sunday 8.30am-6.30pm, Blue Badge holders only, maximum stay four hours. At all other times, Blue Badge holders only, no maximum stay);

- (n) on the north-west side of **Hillgate Place**, to convert 10 metres (33ft) of residents' parking outside the flank wall of No. 25 Hillgate Street, situated in Hillgate Place, double yellow lines;
- (o) on the north-west side of **Hillgate Place**, to convert 30 metres (98ft) of residents' parking outside Nos. 34 to 44 Hillgate Place to double yellow lines;
- (p) on the south-east side of **Hillgate Place**, to convert 27 metres of residents' parking outside Nos. 33 to 43 Hillgate Place to double yellow lines;
- (q) on the north-west side of **Holland Park**, to convert of 6 metres (20ft) of residents' parking outside No. 61 Holland Park to a diplomatic bay (at all times);
- (r) on the north-west side of **Holland Park**, to convert 6 metres (20ft) of diplomatic bay outside No. 60 Holland Park to residents' parking;
- (s) on the north-west side of **Kelfield Gardens**, to convert 3 metres (10ft) of resident parking outside the flank wall of No. 38 Highlever Road, situated in Kelfield Gardens, to double yellow lines. This area will accommodate an on-street cycle hangar unit;
- (t) on the north-west side of Kelfield Gardens, to convert 3 metres (10ft) of double yellow lines outside No. 36 Kelfield Gardens to residents' parking. This change would be made to the traffic orders only
 the area is currently marked as residents' parking on-street as a previous traffic order amendment has not been implemented;
- on the north side of the southern east-west arm of Linden Gardens, to convert 5 metres (16ft) of residents' parking opposite No. 15 Linden Gardens to a Pay-by-Phone visitors' parking bay (hours of control Monday to Friday 8.30am-6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am-1.30pm, maximum stay four hours);
- (v) on the east side of the eastern north-south arm of **Linden Gardens**, to convert 4 metres (13ft) of visitor motorcycle bay outside No. 26 Linden Gardens to residents' parking
- (w) on the west side of the eastern north-south arm of Linden Gardens, to convert one Pay-by-Phone visitor parking bay (hours of control Monday to Friday 8.30am-6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am-1.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours) outside the flank wall of No, 26 Notting Hill Gate, situated in Linden Gardens, to 5 metres (16ft) of visitors' motorcycle bay;
- (x) on the north-west side of Logan Place, to convert 6.6 metres of residents' parking opposite No. 1 Logan Place, to personalised disabled bay No. 620. Should the personalised disabled bay no longer be required, it would be converted back to residents' parking;
- (y) on the south-east side of **Penywern Road**, to convert 6.6 metres (22ft) of residents' parking outside No. 37 Penywern Road, to personalised disabled bay No. 739;
- (z) to continue indefinitely provisions of the Kensington and Chelsea (Free Parking Places, Loading Bays and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 14) Experimental Traffic Order 2020, that being:- on the south-east side of **Phillimore Walk**, to convert 44 metres of single yellow line (Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 6.30pm) opposite the Central Library, Hornton Street, to single yellow line (Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 6.30pm and Sunday 8am to 4pm);
- (aa) on the north-east side of **Redcliffe Gardens**, to convert 20 metres (66ft) of residents' parking outside Nos. 49 to 45 Redcliffe Gardens, to four Pay-by-phone visitor parking bays (hours of control Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 6.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours);
- (bb) on the north-east side of **Redcliffe Gardens**, to convert two Pay-by-phone visitor parking bays (hours of control Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours) outside No. 41 Redliffe Gardens to 11 metres (36ft) of residents' parking;
- (cc) on the south-east side of **Redcliffe Street**, to convert 9 metres (30ft) of residents' parking and 1 metre (3ft) of single yellow line (Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm) outside the flank wall of No. 64 Redcliffe Gardens, situated in Redcliffe Street, to two Pay-by-phone visitor parking bays (hours of control Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours);
- (dd) on the north-east side of **Sloane Avenue**, to convert 5 metres (16ft) of residents' parking outside No. 60 Sloane Avenue, to a visitors' motorcycle bay (Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm);
- (ee) on the north-east side of **Sloane Avenue**, to convert 5 metres of single yellow line (Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 6.30pm) outside No. 50 Sloane Avenue, to residents' parking;
- (ff) on the north-east side of **Stanhope Gardens**, to convert two echelon Residents' Parking bays, opposite 56 and 57 Stanhope Gardens to two Diplomatic Parking Bays (at all times);
- (gg) on the south-west side of **Stanley Crescent**, to convert 3 metres (10ft) of residents' parking outside No. 20 Stanley Crescent to double yellow lines. This area will accommodate an on-street cycle hangar unit;
- (hh) on the south-west side of **Sydney Street**, to convert the first 5 metres (16ft) of residents' parking south of the bus stop outside the Royal Brompton Hospital, on Sydney Street (and opposite St Luke's Gardens) to bus stop marking;
- (ii) on the west side of the eastern arm of **The Boltons**, to convert 15 metres (49ft) of residents' parking opposite Nos. 12 and 13 The Boltons to three Pay-by-phone visitor parking bays (hours of control Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours);

- (jj) on the north-east side of The Vale, to convert 2.4 metres (8ft) of unrestricted highway opposite Mulberry Court, situated in The Vale, to single yellow line (hours of control, Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm);
- (kk) on the north-west side of **Tregunter Road**, to convert 15 metres (49ft) of residents' parking outside the flank wall of No. 28 The Boltons, situated in Tregunter Road, to three Pay-by-phone visitor parking bays (hours of control Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm, maximum stay 4 hours);
- (II) on the north-east side of Warwick Road, to convert 6.6 metres (22ft) of residents' parking outside
 1-86 Durrells House, situated in Warwick Road, to personalised disabled bay No. 740; and
- (mm) to convert single yellow line waiting restriction situated at the following locations to double yellow lines waiting restrictions:
 - i. on the south-west side of **Cromwell Crescent**, for 8 metres (26ft) outside the entrance to the garage of Nos. 1-10 Warwick Mansions, situated in Cromwell Crescent;
 - ii. on the north-east side of **Draycott Avenue**, for 8.5 metres (28ft) outside the entrance to the private car park of No. 10 Draycott Avenue;
 - iii. on the south-east side of **Dulford Street**, for 13 metres (43ft) outside the entrance to Allom and Barlow House, situated in Dulford Street;
 - iv. on the south-east side of **Fawcett Street**, for 6 metres (20ft) outside the flank wall of No. 21 Redcliffe Gardens, situated in Fawcett Street;
 - v. on the north-east side of **Lots Road**, for 10 metres (33ft) outside the delivery gate of Chelsea Academy, outside No. 132 Lots Road;
 - vi. on the north-west side of **Margaretta Terrace**, for 5.5 metres (18ft) at the junction with Oakley Street;
 - vii. on the south-east side of **Margaretta Terrace** for 5.5 metres (18ft) at the junction with Oakley Street;
 - viii. on the south-west side of Oakley Street, for 7 metres (23ft) outside No. 82 Oakley Street;
 - ix. on the inside kerbline of **Ovington Square**, for 13 metres (43ft) opposite the flank wall of No. 1 Ovington Gardens, situated in Ovington Square, and opposite No. 4 and No. 6 Ovington Square;
 - x. on the south side of **Southern Row**, for 8 metres (26ft) outside the vehicular entrance to the off-street car park of Octavia House, situated in Southern Row;
 - xi. on the north-west side of **Tavistock Road**, for 8 metres (26ft) outside Nos. 40 and 42 Tavistock Road; and
- (nn) to modify the traffic order definitions of certain other parking places and waiting restrictions so they better reflect what is currently on the ground (there would be no change to the way restrictions and parking places currently operate).
- 3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 26th August 2021 and of all other relevant documents can be obtained for inspection by emailing trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk, quoting reference: June Misc. 2021 and can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made at The Customer Service Centre, Kensington Town Hall, Hornton Street, London W8 7NX.
- 4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
