NORLAND ROAD – PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE

*The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. **) Traffic Order 2022*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to provide a pedestrian and cycle zone in part of Norland Road. All vehicles other than pedal cycles would be banned from entering the paved area in that part of Norland Road that extends southwards from its junctions with Queensdale Road to its southern extremity.
