OAKWOOD COURT TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES (NCIL HO8)

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") proposes, under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to construct the type of road humps knows as "sinusoidal road humps" at the following locations in Oakwood Court (measurements are given from the centre line of the road hump):
 - (i) 2 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 1 to 14 and 1 to 7 'Manderley' Oakwood Court;
 - (ii) 4 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 117 to 132 and 133 to 148 Oakwood Court;
 - (iii) 6 metres west of the common boundary of Nos. 51 to 62 and 63 to 84 Oakwood Court;
 - (iv) in-line with the north facing facia of Nos. 117 to 132 Oakwood Court; and
 - (v) 4 metres west of the common boundary of Nos. 1 to 3 'Oakwood Mansions' and 85 to 100 Oakwood Court..

[Note: Each "sinusoidal road hump" would be an elevated section of carriageway with a round top, 75mm millimetres higher at its highest point than the surrounding carriageway, varying between approximately 8 metres and 10 metres wide and approximately 3.7 metres in length].

- 2. The road humps are being introduced as part of a scheme intended to reduce traffic speeds on Oakwood Court.
