The Kensington and Chelsea (Housing Estates) (Off-Street Parking Places and Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 2024

 - (b) **Longlands Court Housing Estate -** to convert RBKC-Housing Resident Permit Holders (LLC) bay (parking bay number 17), to RBKC-Housing Disabled Parking bay (LLC 06);
 - (c) Longlands Court Housing Estate to convert RBKC-Housing Disabled Parking bay (LLC 02), to RBKC-Housing Resident Permit Holders (LLC) bay (parking bay number 12); and
 - (d) **Longlands Court Housing Estate -** to convert a RBKC-Housing motorcycle parking bay between RBKC-Housing residents' parking bays Nos. 9 and 10, to hatched markings;
