OFF-STREET RBKC HOUSING PARKING BAY PROVISIONS IN IN HENRY DICKENS COURT ESTATE

The Kensington and Chelsea (Housing Estates) (Off-Street Parking Places and Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 10) Order 2021

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 15th April 2021 have made the above-mentioned Order under sections 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect the Order will be in respect of the Henry Dickens Court housing estate to convert a RBKC Housing Resident Permit Holders Bay (number 23), to a RBKC Housing Personalised Disabled Bay (HDC07);
3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 22nd April 2021 and of all other relevant documents can be obtained for inspection until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made by emailing trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk, quoting reference: Housing Amend 10.
4. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
