The Kensington and Chelsea (Housing Estates) (Off-Street Parking Places and Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2021

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea on 19th August 2021 have made the above-mentioned Order under sections 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general effect the Order will be in respect of the West Row housing estate to convert two RBKC Housing Personalised Disabled Permit Parking Bays Bay (Numbers WER01 and WER04), to two RBKC Housing Permit Holder Parking Bays (WER). [Note: The change to bay WER04 will be made to the traffic order only the area is currently marked as a RBKC Housing Permit Holder Parking Bay as a previous traffic order amendment has not been implemented.]
- 3. A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 26th August 2021 and of all other relevant documents can be obtained for inspection by emailing trafficorders@rbkc.gov.uk, quoting reference: Housing Amend 1 and can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of six weeks from the date the Order was made at The Customer Service Centre, Kensington Town Hall, Hornton Street, London W8 7NX.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
