## SECOND HOME PERMITS

The Kensington and Chelsea (Charged–For Parking Places) (Amendment No. \*\*) Order 202\*

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce second home permits which would be available for use under the same conditions, including at the same times and in the same parking places, as the Council's on-street residents' permits. Second home permits would be available to those liable to pay Council Tax at premises listed as a second home on the Council's Council Tax database and there would be a maximum of one second home permit per premises at any one time and a maximum of 2,000 second home permits granted by the Council at any one time.
- 3. The charge for a second home permit would be the same as for the Council's on-street residents' permit, which for the time being is as follows:
