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## **Sunbeam Gardens Playground Refurbishment**

#### Background

With the current play equipment in Sunbeam Gardens coming to the end of its life span and in need of replacement, Kensington and Chelsea Council sought the views of the local community on how the playground could be improved.

#### **Consultation Methodology**

The Council wanted to get resident views on what they wanted to see in the park, including playground equipment, activities, and seating. A consultation launched in September 2021, closing on 17 October 2021. An online survey was made available to the public on Kensington and Chelsea's Consultation and Engagement Hub, and members of the Parks Projects Team carried out in person surveys in Sunbeam Gardens Park.

The activity ran from 06/09/2021 to 17/10/2021

#### Report

A total of 36 surveys were returned by the deadline. This report contains data tables and comments detailing the responses to the survey questions. Percentage figures from this document should be used with caution due to the low number of total responses.
