THURLOE STREET – PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE

The Kensington and Chelsea (Prescribed Routes) (No. *) Traffic Order 2022

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce a Pedestrian and Cycle Zone in the section of Thurloe Street situated west of the eastern boundary of No. 25 Thurloe Street. With the exception of access for loading which would be permitted between 7am and 10am on Mondays to Sundays inclusive, all motor vehicles would be prohibited from entering or being in the pedestrian and cycle zone. [Note: Vehicles used by the emergency services and vehicles required for emergency work carried out by utility companies would be exempt from this restriction].
